6. Executive Report:

a. **Executive meeting** – Kevin Carswell & Jack Buckham, Team 73 fundraisers contracted to raise revenue to support extra-curricular activities across the district, made a presentation to the DPAC executive. The Executive will follow up with

some queries. Any PAC wishing to learn more about their activities is encouraged to arrange a presentation.

- b. **School Board meetings** The budget preparations for the following fiscal year are starting.
- c. **Dr. Sullivan meetings** Technology Policy and Textbook Policy are being reviewed. Only 2-3 percent of eligible students are choosing to write optional provincial exams,., since they are no longer required by universities and they carry a high risk of dropping the in-class marks. The SD will continue to look for ways of scheduling exam week to make it more effective.

d. Website –. Executive was queried on adding a 'home' button.

7. Committee Reports:

- a. **Parent Education** 32 persons attended the Bullying Webinar. License cost was \$100.00. Rosalind Wiseman event is being planned for April 16, 2012.
- b. **Parent Leadership Task Force** They are continuing to follow up with stakeholder groups. Parent survey is open until month-end.
- c. **DPAC Rep reports & queries** Exam week: Some PAC's were not aware that schools handled the schedule for the week differently. Further followup info is being sought. DPAC will forward parent input to the district (removing identifiers). There were comments on the consolidated Graduation process, and opinions are being sought on its effectiveness
