



The Rotary Club of Kamloops Daybreak is happy to support community youth groups by making a donation in exchange for volunteer hours in the Cooper's and Save-on Foods Family Fun Zone at the Interior Savings Daybreak Rotary Ribfest 2013.

Ribfest is a community celebration that will take place August 9, 10, and 11, 2013.

All volunteers must be a minimum 12 years of age.

For volunteers under the age of 18, one adult must volunteer for every four youth volunteers.

All volunteers aged 18 and over must have a criminal record check; the criminal record check will be done free of charge by the City of Kamloops and the RCMP.

For a commitment of 50 volunteer hours (20 shifts x 2.5 hours/shift), the Rotary Club of Kamloops Daybreak will provide a \$500.00 donation to the community youth group. A commitment of 100 hours (40 shifts) will give the maximum donation of \$1,000.00.

There will be a maximum \$5000.00 granted for youth group volunteers. On a first come basis.
