From the DPAC Meeting of Feb 15, 2011

- 1. "Plug your PAC" Kindergarten and Grade 8 Orientations are upcoming, this may be the best opportunity to get PAC involvement from parents who are new to your school. Ask your principal for an opportunity to speak or to present at the orientation.
- 2. Parent Leadership Task Force: The survey for parents is open until the end of February, and takes about 5 minutes. Please encourage responses. The link is on our homepage, at http://dpac.sd73.bc.ca.
- **3. 2011 Satisfaction Survey:** For students in grades 4, 7, 10 and 12, and their parents and school staff in public schools. The survey is available until April 15, and takes about 10 minutes. High School Graduation Process: *seeking feedback* Two years ago, SD73 began a coordinated approach to grad, where all high schools used MacArthur Island Curling Rink for commencement ceremonies, and parents took over the organization of any grad dinner/dance activities. An initial review after the first year was done, and DPAC is now asking for parent perceptions on how the arrangement is working out.
- 8. Bullying: *seeking feedback* A query/concern to arose out of our Bullying Webinar: to examine whether SD73 bullying policy 903.1 is being interpreted and implemented consistently across the various schools. We are seeking comments on how the bullying policy is being applied.
