



FOODSAFE 2015

Level I course

Interior Health requires that at least one member of any group that is preparing food, whether for sporting concessions, hot lunches, etc has a Foodsafe certificate. The certificates are valid for 5 years, at which time a renewal course must be completed. All certificates issued prior to July 29, 2013 expire at July 29, 2018. See www.foodsafe.ca for details.

This course generally carries a fee of about \$80 to \$200.00 per participant (as an example, online course fee is \$110.00). DPAC will be paying the participant fees. Either the PAC or the attendee is expected to pay the \$20.00 course material, and \$5.00 to recover the cost of a light lunch which is provided.

The course is offered to PAC members as a service from your DPAC to assist in compliance with requirements, in order to provide services to our students.
